


FRAME TAPESTRY – BLUE

WOODFIRED TAPESTRY






Wood firing is a slow, communal and elemental process. This piece was woodired at the Community Arts Center in Wallingford Pennsylvania. with a group of 12 people, where each person takes shifts over the course of 48 hours to support the continuous stoking of the fire.




MATERIALS

Made of a mixture of high grog and smooth woofired clay. each pieces is left unglazed to showcase the ash and flame from the fire. Hung with walnut dowels and mounting hardware.





WATERFALL TAPESTRY









FLW TAPESTRY







GLASS

This work represents a series of explorations through blowing glass into Susan's woven ceramic pieces, transforming negative space into positive form.


The woven forms are sacrificed in the process, leaving the lasting memory of their impression; a visual reminder that letting go of the old is necessary to make space for the new. One of a kind, bespoke pieces.

Custom commissioned pieces start at \$1000, for roughly 5.5 x 7 in size and up depending on scale and complexity.



INFINITY


Sora means "sky" and represents those things beyond our everyday experience.

Inspired by the ingenuity of Japanese basketry art, the process behind these vases is a combination of structure and serendipity. Each piece is constructed from twelve, hand-cut clay strips that are woven in bundles of three, starting upside down. When the time is right, the form is flipped, letting gravity and fire determine it's final resting position. The variation expected is shown in the photos. Dried arrangements only.
